








PLOT PLAN TYPE A










PLOT PLAN TYPE B





PLOT PLAN TYPE C



IN TOUCH WITH NATURE

As a resident of Saadiyat Reserve, you'll share your community with a number of beautiful animals who also call this natural island home. Saadiyat's sandy dunes, dense mangroves and rolling golf course greens provide a safe habitat for a variety of birds, mammals and reptiles. Many of which are the last of their kind.

Which is why conservation is such an important factor of life on Saadiyat Island. A number of organisations work tirelessly to protect these vulnerable species. Including the Environment Agency Abu Dhabi (EAD) who look after more than 50,000 animals across the Emirate.

Under their care, the once endangered Arabian oryx has made a remarkable comeback. 26,000 of the previously endangered houbara bustard bird have been bred and released. The notoriously elusive dugong has seen a rise in numbers off the shores of Abu Dhabi. And on Saadiyat Island, the endangered Hawksbill Sea Turtle has found home. The population of these turtles had declined by eighty percent in the past century. But now, in the EAD protected sand dunes alongside Saadiyat Beach, the once criticallyendangered turtles have found a safe nesting place to return to every year and lay their eggs.

It's not just the EAD who care for them. During hatching season, local volunteers patrol the beach at dawn; spotting and protecting nests, watching hatchlings make their way to the ocean and helping to rescue those that wash up.

The patrol is a heart-warming show of solidarity. A community coming together to make an uncertain future much more hopeful. To join the patrol or to find out how you can do your bit for the wildlife of Saadiyat Island, visit connectwithnature.ae.
